



BENEDICTINE PARK – 333 Wallace Road, Bedford, NH - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There is a lot when you pull in.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - The photographer will be to the left of the parking lot.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This is ALL grass or other soft ground. Spike heels WILL sink. They are fine to bring but if you want to best utilize this location pick a pair that is easy on and off so you can remove them so we can walk between spots in the park.

PLUM ISLAND BEACH – 10 82nd Street, Newburyport, MA - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There are several lots available. They all (except very few spaces) require payment. Parking can cost upwards of \$20 - \$30 although we try to avoid the weekends and other high-traffic times to best utilize this location.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - The photographer will be towards the beach that is behind the buildings. This beach overlooks the mouth of the Merrimack River and offers tons of different spots for photos. Look for a pier – Keep scrolling for screenshots with directions.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This is mostly sand (it is a beach after all!). There is a fishing house we may utilize but we recommend shoes that are beach appropriate. Many of our seniors bring flip-flops and may add different shoes for a seated poses. Spike heels WILL sink. Some seniors rock sneakers, etc. and those work too!

WATERFRONT & BOARDWALK – 38 Merrimac Street, Newburyport, MA - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There are several lots available. They all come with a cost, but it is reasonable (usually it will be under \$10). There are kiosks but most people pay via one of the recommend apps. There is significant signage with instructions.

Where do I meet the Photographer? – The photographer will be at the end of the wooden boardwalk closest to the parking lots. When you are looking at the river, you will see the Tuscan Sea Restaurant (which is directly on the water) to the left and the beginning of the wooden boardwalk on the right. We will be at the beginning of the boardwalk. If you are near the stone wall with columns you are at the wrong end, walk the boardwalk with the river on the right.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This location features a stunning traditional New England wooden boardwalk that spike heels WILL slip between, please be conscious when selecting your shoes for your session so that we can safely utilize this location.

VILLAGE COMMON – 15 Bell Hill Road, Bedford, NH - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There is a lot when you pull in.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - The photographer will be waiting in the grassy area at the beginning of the walkway that leads out to the gazebo.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This location has both soft and hard ground. Spike heels WILL sink so be sure that you are comfortable in heels regardless of ground type.



NUBBLE LIGHTHOUSE – Sohier Park Road, York, ME - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There is a lot when you pull down the road on the right of the road, and straight ahead towards the lighthouse.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - The photographer will be waiting at the entrance of the gift shop where the bathrooms are located.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This location has both soft and hard ground. Spike heels WILL sink so be sure that you are comfortable in heels regardless of ground type. There are rocks that are sometimes available for walking/climbing depending upon the senior/photographers comfort level. Please be sure that your shoe(s) allow you to fully utilize this location.

PRESCOTT PARK – 3 State Street, Portsmouth, NH – small parking lot - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – This can be a challenging location for parking. The address listed above has a small parking lot that has occasional spots available, there is also a small parking lot at 1 Harbour Pl, Portsmouth, NH, and there is street parking. Please be sure to leave plenty of time to find parking and still arrive to your session on time.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - 65 Marcy Street, Portsmouth, NH – Approximate Meeting Spot Address with Photographer – The photographer will be in the park next to the flower garden (with multiple fountains) next to the walking path, overlooking the water.

No, this location is NOT dog friendly except for required service animals.

Important Facts about this Location – This location has both soft and hard ground. Spike heels WILL sink so be sure that you are comfortable in heels regardless of ground type. There are lots of spots that are within walking distance so please be sure to wear shoes you can walk in.

ALLIANCE PARK – 350 Main Street, Amesbury, MA - Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There is a small lot right at park on the river and if that is full you can park behind the white church across the street from the park.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - The photographer will be waiting in the grassy area on the river.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This location has both soft and hard ground. Spike heels WILL sink so be sure that you are comfortable in heels regardless of ground type.

WINDHAM TRAIN DEPOT – 3 Depot Road, Windham, NH – Keep Scrolling for Screenshots of Each Location!

Parking – There is a lot across the street from the rail car.

Where do I meet the Photographer? - The photographer will be waiting in the grassy area next to the rail car across the street.

Yes, this location is dog friendly, however we recommend that someone else attend to help manage your pup for most of your session.

Important Facts about this Location – This location has both soft and hard ground. Spike heels WILL sink so be sure that you are comfortable in heels regardless of ground type.
